




## Research Integrity online course – Registration

1. Go to <https://courses.epigeum.com/>
2. Click on the icon “User Login” in the top right-hand corner and select ‘register’



3. Fill in the fields and insert the following token into the ‘token’ field: **3bd53ca1**

4. Once you have completed the registration, you will receive an activation link via e-mail.


### Research Integrity, Second Edition
